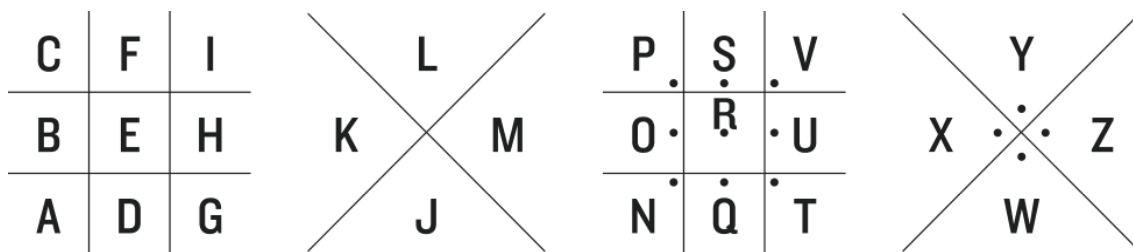




# CLASSIFIED FILE 5: PIGPEN CODE

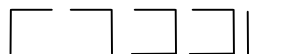
The Pigpen Code may have a funny name, but it's a cool way to share messages. The Pigpen Code uses drawings in place of letters of the alphabet. To figure out what the drawings mean, you need to arrange all the letters in the alphabet so they look like little pigs in pens.

## PIGPEN ALPHABET



## ENCODING

To write your coded message, substitute each letter with the drawing of its 'pen'. For example, 'Gabbi' would look like this:



What you end up with is a message that looks like it's written in an ancient language, but as long as your friend knows the pigpen drawings, they'll be able to work it out.

## DECODING

When you get a message written with the pigpen code, you need to match up each of the drawings with its letter to decode it. Try this one:



Answer: = = = = =
